What's involved?

Cadetship is open to Year 12 students transitioning into university and is a three to five year program, dependent on the length of your degree. We support young people studying a range of academic disciplines and our professtional workplace sponsors represent the diversity of career options available. Our partnerships include the corporate, government and social purpose sectors and every workplace sponsor provides a mentor to guide and support you through your placement.

Everyone in the program takes part in our Professional development program that is offered in a mix of residential and evening activies each year. The residential activies take place at our Malmsbury Camp, on the beautiful lands of the Dja Dja Wurrung people. Evening learning events usually take place in Melbourne CBD and often include guest presenters tapping into our inpiring Cadet alumni crew and sometimes people from our sponsor companies.

Our aim with these sessions is to build on the skills and behaviours required for success in the professional world.

Cadetship is more than a scholarship or internship. It is a holistic approach to the development of a young person.



Will it get me a job?

We often get asked if workplace sponsors offer Cadets a job at the end of the program. The short answer is yes, some do, but it's not a pre-requisite for supporting our program. More importantly, three years down the track you have your degree, heaps of professional training, an amazing network, and money can't buy professional work experience.

So can anyone join the program?

No. Our Cadetship program is for young people facing difficult circomstances. For example, you may be first in your family to go to university or maybe money is tight in your home, or maybe you've recently arrived in Australia and have a limited support network.

We'll respect this. So will the other people in the program they get it, they've been there too.

How do I apply?

You can download and complete an application form from our website and return it to info@doxa.org.au. We then shortlist people and if your ATAR grade gets you into your course we'll then interview you and match you with a workplace sponsor. For most of our partners that means studying a degree related to their industry, but some workplaces do offer generalised experience.

The workplace will want to meet you before they confirm the placement but don't stress - we offer an information night and interview support so that you'll feel confident to nail it.
